Toogoom RFB had serious problems when the Davey/Yanmar pump unit mounted on the rear of our Nissan Patrol (light attack vehicle) failed.

Davey Pumps would not supply a wet end (pump) to suit the threaded shaft of the Yanmar crank.

Extensive search revealed that Pumps Australia based in Western Australia had a Wet End Unit that would marry up with the Yanmar shaft.

The Wet End sourced was received promptly by our specialist, AWT (Advanced Water Technology – at Old Maryborough Road Hervey Bay Q4655) who was able to have the pump mated to the Yanmar and reassembled on the Nissan Patrol within 24 hours of receipt of the Wet End from Pumps Australia WA

The Pumps Australia unit has outperformed the old Davey unit in every way both in Lift and Pressure and has at this stage given notice to other well-known brands being used in other operational fire fighting vehicles.

To date the Toogoom RFB is very pleased with the performance of the replacement unit from Pumps Australia WA.
